As far as p. 29, all the words and phrases will be found in the first Vocabulary (p. 95) in the order of the text; from p. 29, only the Notes referring to grammatical difficulties and to the subject-matter will be found in the order of subjects (pp. 131 - 154), whilst for all new words, and old words forgotten, the student is referred to the second (Alphabetical) Vocabulary (p. 155 to the end).
